



Community Partnership Program

A partnership is defined as an organization that hires HMS to conduct video production classes to participants of the organization. Partnerships may be established for the length of a grant, school year or any period that is mutually agreeable.

The objective of this program is to empower inner city youth of Houston by allowing them to create video programming as a form of expression.

The program will work as follows:

- HMS will provide video equipment and an instructor.
- Organization will provide participants and videotapes. Videotapes can be purchased at HMS.
- Organization would pay \$300 for an annual Organizational Producer fee.
- Students will become HMS Youth Producers and may check out video equipment with signature from a representative of the organization. Organization assumes financially responsible if something happens to equipment.
- Classes would meet 2 hours a week for thirteen weeks or all school year depending on your needs at an agreeable location.
- Organization would pay \$75 per hour for up to 10 students or \$100 for up to 20 students.
- Class size would be limited to 20 students.
- All suitable programming will cablecast on Houston MediaSource.
